During 2008 Blyth has had to “step up a gear” to meet customer and regulatory demand. New this year is the MCA approval to build P6 passenger vessels with 3 in our order book. A new production line will be introduced in 2009 to build a brand new Blyth model, this means will have 3 dedicated production lines running continuously throughout 2009.

“Congratulations” to Jonny Andersson & Claes Yngvesson on delivery of their Blyth 12m for Mackerel long lining and potting in Sweden. Not a bit like UK fisherman this vessel is home from home with 3 double berths, luxury lined wheelhouse and leather sofas. She is also set up for some serious fishing with more electronic equipment than your local COMET! Asterix has a sonar pipe fitted which enables scanning & imaging of the sea bed. Sweden is a new market for Blyth and now our first vessel is in place we have received considerable interest from the Swedish, Danish and Norwegian fishing press. Demonstration days are organised in the region and the first is 17th October in Gothenburg. Call us for further information.
